5. **CORRESPONDENCE/INFORMATION RECEIVED:**  
5.1 13/0011/FULL – West View, Drayton Road – Proposed first floor side extension, rendering of existing house, proposed porch infill and additional access – Application Allowed with Conditions upon Appeal to the Planning Inspectorate.
6. **PREVIOUS PLANNING APPLICATIONS APPROVED/REJECTED:**  
6.1 13/0175/LIST – St Marys Catholic Church, Harvington – 2 No. Buttresses to existing listed adjoining exterior wall of the St Mary’s Catholic Church – **Approved.**  
  
6.2 13/0201/FULL – Portland House, Woodrow Lane – Garage and stable block. Stable block not considered at meeting on 8 April, but subsequently dealt with out of Committee. **Objection** due to size of proposed stable block which is out of proportion to the existing property and over-development in the green belt.
7. **NEW PLANNING APPLICATIONS**  
7.1 13/0217/LIST – The Salon, Broughton Cottage, the Village – Replacement of all existing windows with hardwood painted timber frames and double glazed units. **Objection** – proposed windows are not in keeping with adjacent properties or the character of the village.
